Alderney has 10 miles of stunning coast path with many historic fortifications from Roman to WWII. Spot the unique wildlife in the air, on the land and in the sea.

The coast path is way-marked with information of distance to Braye from either direction of travel. Each sign is numbered to correspond with the map overleaf.

There is a letter on each sign. These join up to make the names of some of Alderney's iconic species of flora and fauna. Make a note of each letter in the table on the right to enter our challenge.
