The Coast Path Challenge is a 10 mile route along the spectacular Alderney coastline, taking in breathtaking scenery, historic fortifications and unique wildlife. Start where you like, in either direction, take it at your own pace and in your own time. Upon completion you can claim a free certificate.

The path is way-marked with information of distance to Braye from either direction of travel. Each sign is numbered to correspond with the map overleaf.

There is a letter on each sign. These join up to make the names of some of Alderney's wild residents.

Make a note of each letter in the table on the right to enter our challenge.

Once you've completed all 10 miles and deciphered the words you can claim your free certificate from the Visitor Information Centre in Victoria Street.
